

General information regarding the download and installation of the violin screensavers

The download and installation of these screensavers is fairly straightforward. After you have chosen the screensaver that you would like, click on the hyperlink to begin the download.

If your browser is Microsoft Explorer you will be presented with a dialog box asking where you would like to place the downloaded file. You may wish to mark this down but the key point here is to click the small box asking if you would like to keep the dialog box open after the download is complete. You *want* the box to stay open. After the file transfer is complete simply click on the OPEN button and you will see a window thanking you for acquiring the screensaver. Click on the PROCEED tab and you will be asked if you would like to install the file in the chosen folder or if you would like to choose your own. Unless you have specific requirements it is easiest to just use the default folder. Click O.K. and the file will self extract. You will then be in the screensaver and you will have many options. As a starter I recommend that you stick with the default settings; you can always change them later. Click O.K. and you will be done. You will see a new icon on your desktop called "The ff of Guarneri del Gesu". By clicking on this you will start the screensaver. This is very nice if you want the screensaver to start right away to view the photos or if you have set the password protection this starts this feature immediately. It's also nice as with the new screensavers coming in the future you will be able to easily pick which one you would like to view at a particular time.

To adjust settings at a later date just right click on a blank area of your desktop and go to Properties at the bottom of the list. Click on Properties and you will get to a box called Display Properties. Choose "screensaver" at the top. You can now change your screensaver, change the time to start, and change any of the properties of the screensaver. You can preview your choices by clicking on the Preview box. When you are satisfied with your choices click on the Apply button then O.K.

To remove this screensaver from your computer click on the START button, go to PROGRAMS, and then find "The ff of Guarneri del Gesu" (probably somewhere near the bottom of the list). When you point to this you will be given options on the right and you just click on UNINSTALL and that is it.

If your browser is Netscape you will see a "SAVE AS" dialog box. This is very important. Either mark down the exact location and path or click the BROWSE button and choose a location of your choice. After the download is complete you will need to go to the file at the specified location. The file name is "Guarneri.exe". Once you have found the file just double click it and from that point it is exactly as above starting with the underlined "After the file transfer".

Display Settings: Most of the more recent computer monitors are designed to display at higher resolutions than earlier models. The "norm" a few years ago was 800 x 600. A more common setting these days is 1024 x 768. This screensaver will give more detailed images if your monitor is set to this higher setting and 16 bit color or better. To change your monitor settings right click on a blank area of the desktop then click on Properties. You will then be in the Display Properties dialog box. Select the "Settings" tab and change as you prefer. If you don't like a particular setting you can always change back.
